## Dangerous use of propane heaters

It has been brought to our attention that there have been two recent instances of dangerously modifying the use of propane heaters.

These two photos both show the use of a pony clip to defeat the automatic safety shut off valve from functioning.





Each heater is equipped with a 100% safety shut off push button valve which will automatically stop the flow of gas in the event the heater fails to operate for any reason. When a pony clip is used as shown, it keeps the valve in a constant open position, by-passing the safety features of the heater. This keeps the flow of propane going even if the flame goes out, possibly filling a lunch tent or background holding area with propane, resulting in the extreme danger of carbon monoxide poisoning or an explosion.

Please do not use any tools to keep open the valves on propane heaters.
